





Remarks of Governor Koike at the "Startup Ecosystem Summit 2024" [Press kit]



On Friday, November 29th, Governor Koike took the stage at the "Startup Ecosystem Summit 2024" to reflect on the first anniversary of the opening of the "Tokyo Innovation Base" (hereinafter referred to as "TIB") and to announce new information regarding "SusHi Tech Tokyo 2025" (hereinafter referred to as "STT2025"). The event included updates on the further evolution of TIB and the announcement of the first speakers for STT2025.

(1) About Tokyo Innovation Base

There was an announcement regarding the achievements of TIB over the past year since its preopening, as well as plans for further functional enhancements.

1 Achievements of TIB









- Tokyo Innovation Base (TIB) is a "NODE," a global hub. It serves as a place where diverse players gather and interact, creating various connections.
- To date, approximately 480 events have been held, and over 1,400 startups and supporters have participated in various support programs conducted at TIB.
- The number of registered members using TIB is about 23,000, and the number of visitors over the past year recently surpassed 100,000.
 - *All figures are as of November 22nd.
- Through the various activities of ecosystem players, Japan and Tokyo's startup ecosystem is steadily gaining strength, and the number of Japanese startups active globally has increased over the past year.
- The support network for startups is expanding to large corporations and universities, and initiatives aimed at creating open innovation are also becoming more active.

2 Further Evolution



- To further accelerate the activation of this startup ecosystem, TIB will evolve.
- We will expand the functions of the first floor to create a space for activities and interactions for people challenging various fields.
- Today, as the first step, we held an event on the first floor to support diversity and inclusion.
- Tokyo will become a city that supports challengers in all fields. To realize this vision outlined in our startup strategy, TIB will grow into an even larger platform.
